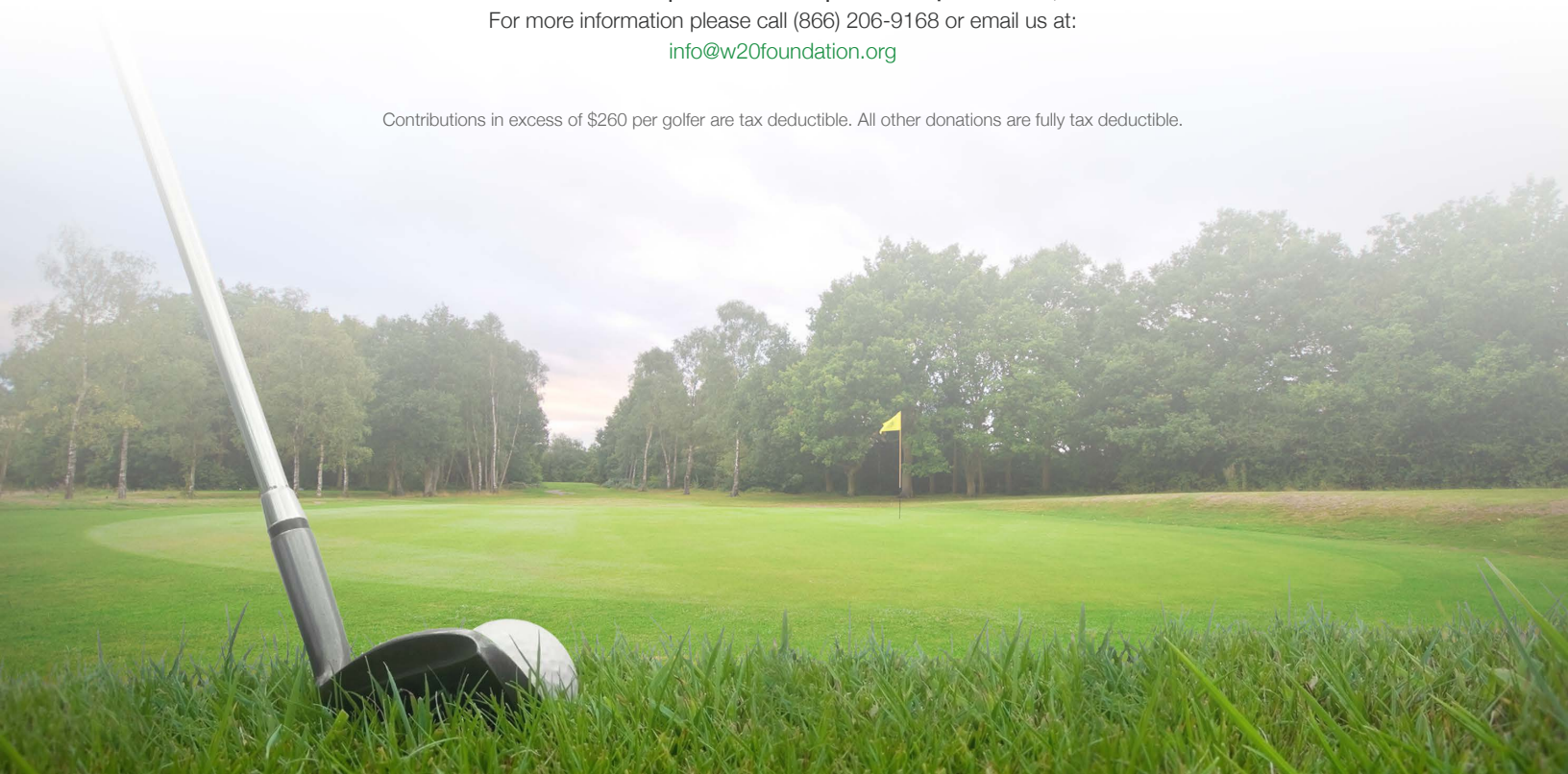

From the LIE East of Exit 41 North, take the LIE West to Exit 41 North (which is Route 107). Upon exiting make your first right onto Route 107. Stay in your left lane and take the left fork Route 107 North. Travel approximately 5 to 7 minutes until Northern Blvd. (25A). Crossover 25A and take your first right onto Hegmans Lane which will lead you about 1 mile directly into the club on Chicken Valley Road.

From the LIE West of Exit 41 North, take the LIE East to Exit 41 North (which is Route 107). Upon exiting you will be on Route 107. Stay in your left lane and take the left fork Route 107 North. Travel approximately 5 to 7 minutes until Northern Blvd. (25A). Crossover 25A and take your first right onto Hegmans Lane which will lead you about 1 mile directly into the club on Chicken Valley Road.

From the NSP East of Exit 35 North, take the NSP West to Exit 35 North (which is Route 107). Upon exiting make your first right onto Route 107. Stay in your left lane and take the left fork Route 107 North. Travel approximately 5 to 7 minutes until Northern Blvd. (25A). Crossover 25A and take your first right onto Hegmans Lane which will lead you about 1 mile directly into the club on Chicken Valley Road.

From the NSP West of Exit 35 North, take the NSP East to Exit 35 North (which is Route 107). Upon exiting you will be on Route 107. Stay in your left lane and take the left fork Route 107 North. Travel approximately 5 to 7 minutes until Northern Blvd. (25A). Crossover 25A and take your first right onto Hegmans Lane which will lead you about 1 mile directly into the club on Chicken Valley Road.
